Family Learning Programmes with Qualifications

These courses will soon be running across the city in a school or children's centre near you – please ask your local school / centre for more information or to request one of these courses to be delivered in your local area:

Managing Children's Behaviour (Communication Skills Qualification)

Develop assertive communication skills so that you are more able and confident to manage difficult conversations and behaviours within your family. Understand what your children need and how to support them with their behaviour.

Award in Supporting your Children in Family Learning

Did you have bad learning experiences at school? Would you like your own child to have a better experience? Build your confidence in encouraging your child to have a good attitude to learning. Gain a qualification about child development that will help your child to succeed at home and in school.

Award in Assertiveness and Confidence Building

Learn to stand up for your rights and develop skills to find ways of getting your desired outcome in situations where you may find it hard to be assertive. Identify benefits of being assertive and in control, looking at strategies for challenging negative thinking.

Story Sacks Qualification

Choose your child's favourite book and create puppets and learning games using the story as a theme in order to stimulate your child's pleasure in reading. Take your story sack home to keep using again and again and identify how and why it helps your child to develop and enjoy their reading skills.

CACHE Level 1 Introduction to Health, Social Care and Children's and Young People's Settings
