In this brochure we have used the following to identify the planned method of delivery:-

- 1 **Classroom-based** classes will be delivered in the centre.
- 2 Blended learning classes will be a mixture of delivery methods. Blended learning is a combination of delivery in centre and directed work to be carried out at home, either on-line or paper-based.
- **On-line classes** will be delivered remotely, via the Internet, supported by the tutor.
- 4 **Distance learning** classes will be delivered solely on-line and at your own convenience.
