The Youth Employment Initiative

Based at Endeavour Learning and Skills Centre, the Youth Employment Initiative (YEI) gives you the opportunity to take the next steps towards employment, education and training.

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVE HÈIIE

The programme offers skills and qualifications for employment and supports with progression opportunities for the next stage of your life.

We offer a range of work-related opportunities, some in weekly 2 hour sessions, and others in one-off courses on individual days.

Courses that may be offered:

- Functional Skills in English at Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 (weekly sessions, exam taken when ready starting 13 September)
- Functional Skills in Maths at Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 (weekly sessions, exam taken when ready starting 15 September)

Progression is built in, so that you can move on to the next level if successful.

- Construction Skills Taster courses in areas such as: Joinery; Tiling; Painting and Decorating (3 hour sessions over 6 weeks starting 17 September)
- CSCS Card Preparation (2 hour sessions over 6 weeks from 16 September)
- Level 1 Health and Safety in Construction (6 sessions running alongside CSCS card preparation from 16 September)
- Food Hygiene Level 1 and 2 (One day courses dates to be arranged)
- Employability Workshops writing a quality CV; developing your interview skills through a mock interview process; career planning (every Tuesday)
