IMPROVERS SPANISH VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

This course is aimed at students who already have an elementary vocabulary knowledge and understanding of Spanish. The Improvers Spanish Virtual Classroom is delivered using the Microsoft Teams app.

In this relaxed, informal course you will cover the skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing however, the emphasis will be on the practical application of the language with many opportunities to practice speaking and understanding.

The grammar will include different tenses and the topics may contain general and personal information, travel, accommodation, food and drink, shopping and directions giving you the opportunity to suggest other topics which meet your interest.

All learning materials are delivered virtually using the Microsoft Teams app and there is formal online tuition for this course. You are required to attend at the stated course time and for the duration of the lesson.

FOOD SAFETY - LEVEL 2

By law, food business operators must ensure that food handlers receive the appropriate supervision and training in food hygiene.

This qualification is suitable for those of you working in a catering environment who are responsible for handling food. It is also the most popular food safety qualification accepted by enforcement officers and auditors.



During this one day course you will cover:

- The importance of food safety procedures and complying with the law
- Microbiological, chemical, physical and allergenic hazards and their controls
- Food temperature control and stick rotation
- The importance of good personal hygiene
- Keeping work areas clean and safe
- Waste disposal

The Award is part of Foundation Learning. It will be signposted to relevant National Occupational Standards where applicable and will reflect the themes of Every Child Matters and Early Years Foundation.

The course will contain:

- The value of play for babies and young children
- Management and organisation in an early years setting
- Roles and responsibilities in an early years setting

DIPLOMA FOR THE EARLY YEARS PRACTITIONER – LEVEL 2

Fuelled by curiosity and wonder, children are extremely fast learners and take in all of their surroundings to grow and develop vital skills to prepare them for school and their future.

As a Level 2 Early Years Practitioner, you'll play a vital role in supporting the social and physical development of children ages 0-5, using imaginative learning techniques, encouraging language and literacy skills, and promoting independence along the way.

If you are interested in a fulfilling and challenging career in childcare within an Ofsted regulated environment, this course is a great starting point.

DEVELOP TRAINING EDUCATION

Topics include:

- Roles and responsibilities of the Early Years Practitioner
- Health and safety of babies and young children in the early years
- Equality, diversity and inclusive practice in Early Years Settings
- Safeguarding, protection and welfare of babies and young children in Early Years Settings
- Understand how to support children's development
- Support care routines for babies and young children
- Support the planning and delivery of activities, purposeful play opportunities and educational programmes
- Promote play in an Early Years Setting

INTRODUCTION TO COUNSELLING SKILLS – LEVEL 1

If you are keen to develop your knowledge and understanding of counselling/helping skills, then our Introduction to Counselling Skills – Level 1 is the perfect course for you!

Counselling/helping skills are useful for anyone who has a personal or professional interest in increasing their knowledge and experience of active listening through self-awareness and personal development.

Training to become a counsellor or learning helping skills can be extremely beneficial and rewarding to you personally and professionally.

It is recognised that these capabilities have become an indispensable and much-valued part of modern-day life and provide a way of making a genuine difference to people.

There are people across the country who work in many different settings - such as in care homes, hospitals, clinics, community centres - and use counselling skills in their professional roles, but are not qualified, professional counsellors.

This short course will help you decide if counselling skills is something you might like to develop in a supportive and fun environment.

During this course you will cover topics such as:

- The issues for which people seek counselling
- How counselling can help people
- Skills used by counsellors
- Empathy in a counselling context
- How self-knowledge enables counsellors to demonstrate acceptance

HEALTH AND SAFETY WITHIN THE WORKPLACE LEVEL 2

Keeping workplaces safe is both a legal and moral obligation, with severe consequences if local health and safety laws are not followed.

The Health and Safety within the Workplace – Level 2 is a market-leading exam used by some of the biggest businesses across the UK to keep their staff compliant with health and safety.

This qualification has been designed specifically for those individuals who are required to have a basic knowledge of health and safety practices that are essential in the workplace. It is also ideal for those entering the workplace for the first time or looking to progress in an organisation.

By the end of the course you will have:

- An understanding of the responsibilities of employers and employees
- Knowledge around the benefits of good health and safety
- Knowledge of steps to a risk assessment and how they can reduce accidents
- Understanding of near misses and ill-health
- Knowledge of typical hazards and controls in a workplace
- Understanding common causes of accidents, near misses and ill-health
- Knowledge of emergency procedures





MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS – LEVEL 1

Run over 12 weeks, Mental Health
Awareness – Level 1 helps raise
awareness and understanding of
mental health problems by exploring
the issues associated with everyday
mental health issues.

As part of this course you will be expected to complete a minimum of one hours work at home in addition to the classroom taught sessions.

You will be exploring the following topics:

- Being aware of what is meant by mental health
- Being aware of some of the responses to mental health issues
- Being aware of cultural diversity in relation to mental health issues
- Being aware of some of the social and personal effects of mental ill-health

The qualification is appropriate for a wide range of individuals with an interest in raising their own understanding of mental health issues. It would complement study in a range of areas, for example citizenship, PSHE, healthcare, social care, counselling and/or public services.

This qualification may also be particularly useful for those working within the voluntary and community sector and for others whose role calls for interaction with the general public in their day to day work.

AWARD IN STRESS AWARENESS – LEVEL 1

If you are looking to gain a core understanding of stress and the effects it can have and how to reduce them, then this qualification is for you.

Learning to cope with unavoidable emotions is essential to living a better quality of life. If you are struggling to manage stress or would like to help others better manage their stress levels, this course is for you.

Stress is related to so many issues in everyday life. Understanding it lays a fantastic foundation for further learning and strategies to use to support positive well-being.

ELEVATE YOUR EXPERTISE You will learn the importance of self-awareness and how small changes can improve your life.

We will teach you how to recognise different types of stress, the factors contributing to these feelings and how they can translate into physical symptoms.

Once you are able to identify stress in yourself, you will explore coping methods, support agencies and how to help others better manage stress.

You will be exploring the following topics:

- What is meant by stress
- Know the effects of stress
- Understand how to recognise stress
- Understand possible causes of stress
- Know ways to prevent and reduce the effects of stress

AWARD IN DYSLEXIA AWARENESS – LEVEL 2

This six week Dyslexia Awareness course offers you knowledge around Dyslexia. You will be provided with lots of information that will help you not only learn about Dyslexia, but also around how to help children, or others, who you come in to contact with.

This course aims to help you develop in an existing role, such as a Teaching Assistant or Learning Support Practitioner – or help you prepare to take on such a role.

COURSES TO ENHANCE YOUR EMPLOYABILITY

AN INTRODUCTION TO NEUROSCIENCE IN EARLY YEARS – LEVEL 2

This course has relevance to anyone with an interest in child development and the factors that affect children's behaviour, emotional well-being, and ability to learn.

It is particularly relevant to early years practitioners, teachers and teaching assistants, childminders and those who work in children's services. It should also be a valuable aid to parents and other primary carers.




This course focuses on the study of neuroscience in Early Years.

Topics include:

- Understanding neurons,
 synaptogenesis and how the social
 brain develops
- Offer breadth and depth of study, incorporating a key core of knowledge
- Understanding self-regulation and the factors that can affect its development
- Understanding types of stress and adverse childhood experiences
- Distinguish between behaviourist and relational approaches to behaviour management

CREATIVE M CERAMICS

CREATIVE CERAMICS – LEVEL 1

Creative Ceramics – Level 1 is for you if you want to advance your practical skills in Pottery, Ceramics and Mixed Media.

It is a largely practical course aimed at potters with solid basic knowledge who feel confident developing a project. This qualification is made up of three units, which are portfolio evidenced. The course aims to develop sculptural knowledge, practically forming, decorating and evaluating the project using clay.

You will be taught how to build up a bust, developing musculature and expression in clay.

You will study three units:

- Explore ceramic resources
- Explore craft ideas
- Create and present final piece of ceramic work

RELAXIN SKILLED CRAFT

CREATIVE CERAMICS – LEVEL 2

Creative Ceramics – Level 2 is for learners who want to advance their practical skills in Pottery, Ceramics and Mixed Media.

This largely practical course is for potters with sound knowledge of ceramic creative processes who feel confident developing a project.

This qualification is delivered over one year and made up of four units, evidenced through portfolio submission. The course aims to develop sculptural and practical knowledge, making and developing bodies of work, glazes and firing processes. You will be taught how to create a largescale sculptural bust, developing musculature and expression in clay, glaze making and have the chance to explore Raku.

You will study four units:

- Develop craft ideas
- Use materials, tools and equipment to develop craft techniques
- Investigate creative enterprise, create and present final piece of ceramic work
- Create, present and evaluate final heritage/traditional crafts item

Teaching Assistants support children with their learning activities in the classroom. They work closely with teachers to make sure pupils enjoy learning in a safe and caring setting. PREPARING TO WORK IN SCHOOLS – LEVEL 1 AWARD

This qualification is about gaining an insight into working in a learning environment, whether this is in a primary, secondary or special school. You will learn about the different types of schools in the education sector and how they are organised.

ESOL CONVERSATION CLUB – ENTRY 1 TO ENTRY 3
