

QUALIFICATION COURSES (5)

FOOD SAFETY – LEVEL 2

By law, food business operators must ensure that food handlers receive the appropriate supervision and training in food hygiene.

This qualification is suitable for those of you working in a catering environment who are responsible for handling food. It is also the most popular food safety qualification accepted by enforcement officers and auditors.

During this one day course you will cover:

- The importance of food safety procedures and complying with the law
- Microbiological, chemical, physical and allergenic hazards and their controls
- Food temperature control and stick rotation
- The importance of good personal hygiene
- Keeping work areas clean and safe
- Waste disposal
- Pest control

HEALTH AND SAFETY WITHIN THE WORKPLACE – LEVEL 2

Keeping workplaces safe is both a legal and moral obligation, with severe consequences if local health and safety laws are not followed.

The Health and Safety within the Workplace – Level 2 is a market-leading exam used by some of the biggest businesses across the UK to keep their staff compliant with health and safety.

This qualification has been designed specifically for those individuals who are required to have a basic knowledge of health and safety practices that are essential in the workplace. It is also ideal for those entering the workplace for the first time or looking to progress in an organisation.

By the end of the course you will have:

- An understanding of the responsibilities of employers and employees
- Knowledge around the benefits of good health and safety
- Knowledge of steps to a risk assessment and how they can reduce accidents
- Understanding of near misses and ill-health
- Knowledge of typical hazards and controls in a workplace
- Understanding common causes of accidents, near misses and ill-health
- Knowledge of emergency procedures

BELIEVE ACHIEVE INSPIRE

EARLY YEARS - LEVEL 1

This qualification is suitable for parents and volunteers wishing to participate in provisions in early years settings and allows you to gain an understanding of the provision of childcare available in early years settings.

The Award is part of Foundation Learning. It will be signposted to relevant National Occupational Standards where applicable and will reflect the themes of Every Child Matters and Early Years Foundation.

The course will contain:

- The value of play for babies and young children
- Management and organisation in an early years setting
- Roles and responsibilities in an early years setting

DEVELOP TRAINING EDUCATION

DIPLOMA FOR THE EARLY YEARS PRACTITIONER – LEVEL 2

Fuelled by curiosity and wonder, children are extremely fast learners and take in all of their surroundings to grow and develop vital skills to prepare them for school and their future.

As a Level 2 Early Years Practitioner, you'll play a vital role in supporting the social and physical development of children ages 0-5, using imaginative learning techniques, encouraging language and literacy skills, and promoting independence along the way.

If you are interested in a fulfilling and challenging career in childcare within an Ofsted regulated environment, this course is a great starting point.

NURTURE EDUCATE INSPIRE

PREPARING TO WORK IN SCHOOLS – LEVEL 1 AWARD

This qualification is about gaining an insight into working in a learning environment, whether this is in a primary, secondary or special school. You will learn about the different types of schools in the education sector and how they are organised.

This classroom-based course will prepare you for further learning while developing an understanding of the teaching and learning environment in a school, how to support the well-being of children and young people and how young people develop basic skills including children's learning in and out of the classroom.

You will learn practical skills and underpinning knowledge to support you on further learning and development.

During the course you will have both taught and practical sessions and you will be expected to produce some written work.

SUPPORTING TEACHING AND LEARNING IN SCHOOLS - LEVEL 1

Teaching Assistants support children with their learning activities in the classroom. They work closely with teachers to make sure pupils enjoy learning in a safe and caring setting. If you like working with children and want to play a part in their education and well-being, this career could be ideal for you.

SUPPORTING TEACHING AND LEARNING IN SCHOOLS - LEVEL 2

This course has been designed to provide learners with an understanding of the knowledge and skills needed when working directly with children and young people in school or college environments. It covers a wide range of areas including children and young people's development, supporting children and young people's positive behaviour, communication and professional relationships. It is aimed at learners working in roles that support pupils' learning in primary, secondary or special schools, as well as colleges.

The course content will be negotiated to meet your needs and will include some of the following:

- Understanding how to keep children safe and well
- children, young people and adults
- You do not require a placement to complete this course, however, you will complete an assessment task to establish if this is the correct level for you

A Teaching Assistant qualification can be beneficial to improving job prospects and gaining substantial knowledge about child development. It is aimed at learners volunteering in roles that support pupils' learning in primary, secondary or

CREATIVE CA CERAMICS

CREATIVE CERAMICS – LEVEL 1

Creative Ceramics – Level 1 is for you if you want to advance your practical skills in Pottery, **Ceramics and Mixed Media.**

It is a largely practical course aimed at potters with solid basic knowledge who feel confident developing a project. This qualification is made up of three units, which are portfolio evidenced. The course aims to develop sculptural knowledge, practically forming, decorating and evaluating the project using clay.

You will be taught how to build up a bust, developing musculature and expression in clay.

CREATIVE CERAMICS – LEVEL 2

Creative Ceramics – Level 2 is for learners who want to advance their practical skills in Pottery, Ceramics and Mixed Media.

This largely practical course is for potters with sound knowledge of ceramic creative processes who feel confident developing a project.

This qualification is delivered over one year and made up of four units, evidenced through portfolio submission. The course aims to develop sculptural and practical knowledge, making and developing bodies of work, glazes and firing processes.

You will be taught how to create a large-scale sculptural bust, developing musculature and expression in clay, glaze making and have the chance to explore Raku.



AN ESOL COURSE WILL HELP YOU TO:

- Improve speaking and listening
- Improve reading and writing
- Gain a qualification

ESOL LIVING AND WORKING IN HULL (ENTRY 1 TO LEVEL 1)

These six week courses will help you to:

- Develop your conversation skills in English in everyday life situations
- Help your confidence in face-to-face situations
- Develop your employment skills i.e. job interviews, explaining things
- Support you to be better equipped to integrate into life here in Hull, England such as talking with your colleagues, your child's school, your GP and your neighbours
- Improve your confidence and promote
 positive well-being
- Move on to further courses, gain qualifications and/or get work

TOPICS CAN INCLUDE:

- Healthy living, well-being and
 looking after your mental health
- Being kind, manners, feelings, emotions and coping mechanisms
- Being safe, including emergency services, internet safety and the law within the UK
- Visits to local venues, such as museums and following The Fish Trail

You can progress from these courses onto an accredited course and achieve a Functional Skills qualification.

This course is run twice a week for two hours per session over six weeks.



CHAMPION YOUR SUCCESS

ESOL CONVERSATION CLUB – ENTRY 1 TO ENTRY 3

This 12 session course will help you to:

- Gain confidence communicating
 with others using English language
- Practice a range of speaking, listening and communication skills
- Practice pronouncing words
- Practice your speaking skills out in the community

This course is run twice a week for two hours per session over six weeks.

ESOL FUNCTIONAL SKILLS – ENTRY 1 TO ENTRY 3

This course will help you develop confidence and improve your skills in everyday life.

English courses help you develop your reading skills, spelling, grammar and punctuation, writing for different purposes and speaking and listening confidently. These skills can help you obtain employment, gain promotions and improve skills in the workplace as well as improving your day to day use of functional English.

Our ESOL Functional Skills courses are fully funded so eligible learners will not have to pay a fee. You may also achieve a qualification.

We have a range of courses delivered in our centre and online.

Most Functional Skills courses are for 12 weeks, with classes twice a week, two and a half hours per session.

After achieving Entry 3 you can progress onto Living and Working in Hull Level 1 with ESOL and then Level 1/Level 2 Functional Skills with our English provision.



ESOL PHONICS

This 12 session course will help you to:

- Learn phonic sounds that will help
 you spell words
- Read words by using knowledge of phonic sounds
- Practice pronouncing words
- Improve confidence and promote
 positive well-being
- Move onto further ESOL courses

This course is run once a week for two hours per session over 12 weeks.

IMPROVE CONFIDENCE AND PROMOTE POSITIVE WELL-BEING

ESOL WRITING COURSE – ENTRY 3

This writing course will help you to:

- Write better sentences and short texts about a variety of different topics
- Discuss topics with the class and learn new vocabulary
- Use ideas to write
- Improve your spelling, punctuation
 and grammar
- Increase your confidence in writing, ready to progress to a functional skills course

This course is run twice a week for four weeks or once a week for eight weeks depending on availability.

FUNCTIONAL SKILLS

FUNCTIONAL SKILLS MATHS AND ENGLISH EQUIPS YOU WITH EVERYDAY SKILLS.

All of these courses, including the qualifications, are offered free for you to access and are fully funded by the Government.

When you apply to join our courses, we will assess your current skills and advise the best solution for you from our suite of available courses.

Fast Track courses offer the chance to complete courses in half the time by completing additional work independently which is set by your tutor. You must be motivated and able to complete the extra work in between classes to give yourself the best chance of success.

If you are 19 or over and do not already have a Level 3 qualification or higher, you can access a free Level 3 qualification. Level 3 is equivalent to an advanced technical certificate or diploma, or A levels.

FAST TRACK COURSES

Fast Track courses offer the chance to gain a qualification in just 10 weeks, with additional sessions to attend to complete your examinations. You have different choices of how you would like to do this...

ONLINE WITH INDEPENDENT LEARNING – 10 WEEKS

Attend one live session online using Microsoft Teams and complete additional independent work, which is set by your tutor.

During this course, you will need to direct your own learning and manage your time well to meet deadlines. It is a great option if you are looking to gain a qualification to enter higher education or university because you need to be motivated in order to set regular time aside every week to do your homework, to give yourself the best chance of success.

TWICE WEEKLY IN CLASS -10 WEEKS

Attend two sessions in our learning centre each week to complete five hours a week of your chosen subject. The benefit of this course is that you will have the tutor's support throughout your learning. Independent work is encouraged to help you to achieve alongside the two classes, but you will have chance to work with other learners and practice and develop your new skills within a group setting. Sessions run over two separate days and also offer a crèche facility.



A VARIETY OF PROGRAMMES...

ONLINE LEARNING

Attend a live online session with your tutor every week and utilise access to our Microsoft Teams classroom to support your learning and revision at home throughout the course. For those of you with busy lives, caring responsibilities, little time or a limited ability to travel, online learning could be the right choice for you. You can complete your learning and enrolment online if you tell us that you would like to follow this option.

CLASSROOM LEARNING

If you prefer to be in a classroom to learn, with the opportunities to meet other people and listen to a range of opinions from within your group along with feeling more able to ask questions of your tutor, then this is for you!

Courses run for two and a half hours a week over 20 weeks. Crèche support is available within The Avenues Adult Education Centre to support your attendance at the course, if needed, for a small fee.

FUNCTIONAL SKILLS FOR FAMILIES

These courses will be available in your local school or children's centre. Sessions are for two hours a week over 26 weeks and while they are delivered in the community, you may already be attending the venue to take and collect your child. Crèche support is often available for those who have young families still at home. Keep an eye out for our publicity or ask your school if they would be interested in hosting a course.

GET TO GRIPS WITH GRAMMAR -11 WEEKS

- Use our Level 1 and 2 packs to identify and use English grammar with a focus on tenses, subject-verb agreement and using articles
- Use grammar to produce texts and writing that is needed in everyday life
- Use accurate grammar when communicating in different formal and informal ways
- Recall examples of when and how to use English grammar to help you to read, write and communicate more precisely

Attending this course will help you to prepare to move onto the Functional Skills English courses at Levels 1 and 2.

CONFIDENT COMMUNICATIONS – 11 WEEKS

DIGITAL AND T SKILLS

WHERE DO I BEGIN WITH LEARNING HOW TO USE A COMPUTER?

These short courses help you to start at the very beginning and develop the basic skills you need to start our entry level qualifications in using computers. Build your skills and your confidence at the same time!
